Daily Prayers along with Prayer Journal and Time Log

Prayer time does not just involve biblical concepts, principles, requests, confessions and needs, but involves interacting with the person of Christ.

- My destiny is assured-I choose not to worry.
- God is in control. He is sovereign. Isa. 6 Gen. 1:1 Rev. 5
- Today I choose to be happy in the Lord.
- Others have done harmful things, but God meant it for my good. Phil 1:12 "But I want you to know, brethren, the things which happened to me have actually turned out for the furtherance of the gospel." (which glorifies God),
- I will persist without exception. I will endure.

- May you humble me as I look at the sins of others. 'But for the grace of God that would be me'.
