What's Happening in Belize?

The Belize Bible College (BBC) began in September of 2016, with 10 students enrolled. Last November, the school was temporarily closed due to a site survey requirement and

additional paperwork requested by the education department of Belize. The requirements have been completed and submitted, so now the school is waiting the assignment of a new start date from the government. Please be in prayer for this to happen soon so the students can get back to class.

The first semester of the BBC resulted in 10 students each receiving 3 credit hours for their work. God has a purpose for all things, and we are trusting in Him.

The new classroom building is about 90% completed. We hope to begin using the facility next fall. I plan to travel to Belize this spring to teach a two-week course so that the students enrolled in the college will earn 3 additional credit hours. Please pray for Ashley and Caleb as I am away from them.

What's Ahead?

We will continue to travel, share our calling, and seek partners in our ministry in Belize.

We will finish up our ministry at First Baptist Church in Floresville on March 15, 2017,

Our target date to be in Belize is in May of 2017. This will give us more time to raise support. We are 65% funded, and our goal is to be at 80% before we head to Belize.

We will be building our missionary residence during the months of May and June. The cost of the residence is \$20,000. We have raised \$10,000 toward this project.
