GUEST SPEAKER

Retired Chaplain Colonel Jimmy M. Browning will be speaking today in Pastor Mike's absence. Chaplain Browning was the Sr. Chaplain, 502nd Air Base Wing and Joint Base San Antonio, which includes Randolph AFB, Fort Sam Houston, and Lackland AFB. Chaplain Browning was ordained to Christian ministry on July 29, 1979. He served as a youth minister, a hospital chaplain of a 1,500-bed regional hospital and as a senior pastor for six years in two Baptist churches in Texas. The Air Force commissioned him as a chaplain candidate on November 6, 1979. He became a Reserve chaplain as an Individual Mobilization Augmentee effective March 6, 1986, and entered active duty on August 26, 1989. Chaplain Browning has degrees from the University of Texas, Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, and Boston University, along with various military educational programs. We look forward to hearing Col. Browning share a word from the Lord with us today.
