Opened in 2001, STPCC has been offering hope, help, truth, and love to women and men facing unplanned pregnancies. Their mission is "Saving Babies and Restoring Families." In 2016, the STPCC was visited by 1,764 people, performed 298 pregnancy tests, performed 15 first-trimester ultrasounds, counseled 10 post-abortion clients, and shared the gospel 597 times!
