The ministry goal of TLW-PH is to connect youth to God and His plan for absolute purity. This goal is accomplished by God's grace as the ministry focuses on evangelism, discipleship and leadership development. The TLW-PH ministry has been given incredible opportunities to minister to young people in the Philippines in both public and private schools. The message of purity is critically important to the Filipino culture and True Love Waits teaches that ultimately a life of purity comes from a heart of purity towards God. Teaching God's principles from the Bible about purity in school assemblies and small groups allows students to understand and accept God's definition of a heart of purity.

Paul's primary ministry focus will be:

- Equipping Filipino churches in their efforts to evangelize and disciple Filipino youth through use of the TLW-PH ministry strategy
- Developing, launching, and supporting new discipleship material for the TLW-PH ministry that is gospel-focused, effective, and reproducible
- Strengthening the ministries of TLW-PH through administrative support
- Encouraging and equipping the TLW-PH staff and volunteer leaders
- Supporting the TLW-PH ministry training process and working to insure the training material is effective, understandable, and reproducible

Sherry will be working with the TLW-PH ministry by loving and supporting the staff and volunteers and by discipling them in more informal settings. Paul and Sherry will be joined by their 18 year old daughter Hannah who believes God will be using her to minister in the Philippines as well.

### Citizen Survey-Karnes & Wilson Counties

Under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires communities to develop a mitigation plan to minimize or eliminate the long-term risk to human life and property from unknown bazards and to be eligible for certain grat



from unknown hazards and to be eligible for certain grant funding.

Along with Karnes and Wilson Counties, the multi-jurisdictional mitigation plan will include the incorporated cities and school districts as participants, along with the San Antonio River Authority and other identified stakeholders.

The required plan includes public meetings to develop specific mitigation strategies unique to each entity. The first public meetings will be held in May with a notice in your local newspaper of time and place. In addition to the required meetings, the communities are conducting an on-line community survey to understand residents' top needs.

Hard copies of the survey can be found at the court house, city hall, and library. Please return by June 9, 2018.
