Utah Mission Trip Report - Rebekah Dickerson

First Family,

I cannot thank y'all enough for your prayers and support for the SWBTS Utah Mission Team. We could feel the power of prayer, and we saw it all around us as well. I am writing this as an update on what's going on in my life as well as to share a little of my recent trip to Utah. Beginning with my life, I am now confident that the Lord is calling me to move to Utah some time after graduation. Before the trip I was still unsure if that is where I am supposed to go, but I was sure that Mormons are "my people." Now, I am confident that Utah will be my home likely within the next few years. I have several friends there now who have become my family, and my heart longs to be with them again, witnessing to the lost in Provo, Utah. They became my home and have opened up their arms for me to join them in Utah, and I plan to. Now, regarding my recent trip to Utah and all that happened, I can



tell you that the Lord is certainly moving in the hearts and lives of those there! They are seeing more and more lost people be saved and more and more Christians are moving there to start/join ministries. There are ministries that reach the Fundamentalist communities (the Mormons that still practice polygamy) and the Lord is doing great work there! Those ministries with the Fundamentalist communities are what I want to do and where I want to be. The people in some of these communities, the women especially, experience abuse and loneliness due to the fact that they are not their husband's only wife, and possibly not his most beloved one of the several that he has. There are fundamentalist communities that have suicide rates that are through the roof, one which averaged a suicide a week. However, when someone started a ministry to help reach this particular group, the suicide rate decreased. So, you can see that the Lord is really moving there!

I have a few prayer requests for y'all if you would be willing to pray for these things. First, I have a few friends that are either beginning to seek the truth and leave Mormonism, who have already found the truth and are transitioning out of the LDS Church, or are ex-Mormons who have become believers but are having to remain undercover to stay off the LDS Church's radar and not lose everything that they have. When they say you have to be willing to open up your home for ministry, they mean that literally in Utah for many who leave the LDS faith for Christianity lose quite literally everything they have. They are the ones living out the parable of the man who sold everything he had for the treasure he found in the field. They are giving up everything they have ever known and loved to follow Jesus, and they could all really use your prayer. Second, please pray for the believers there who are witnessing to those there. The Provo/Orem area is the most unreached Metro area in the entire nation, having a population of 0.5% Evangelical Christians for the entire area. This place, as of 2010, has a population of 527,000, and for every 20,300 people, there is one believer. Imagine sitting in a full football stadium and realizing that you may be the only believer there. It is a very, very dark place. The spiritual warfare there is unbelievable, and many of us on the trip experienced it while there. It can be a very discouraging thing to be one of very few believers in the area, and I know the believers that are working there to share the good news of Jesus would greatly appreciate your prayers. So please pray for them while they follow the Lord's will and bring the gospel to a very dark place, risking all they have for this.

Again, thank you so much for all y'all are doing, and please, when you meet someone who is Mormon (or any lost person), treat them with love, respect, and kindness. Share truth with them, but make sure that you do it in love and not simply to win an argument. Check your heart when you do it and make sure that it's in the right place. Let it be the Holy Spirit that speaks, not you. I can recount times where I didn't let the Holy Spirit speak through me and I can tell you that the conversation was an utter disaster. So, take it from me, and let the Holy Spirit lead, but be willing to do what He leads you to do.

Thank you, Helping Hands class, for ministering to our family's needs. You exhibit what God teaches. Thank you, my sisters.


