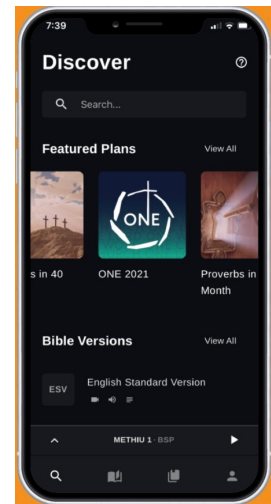

HOW IT WORKS

LISTEN

1. Visit the APP STORE or GOOGLE PLAY and download the BIBLE.IS app.
2. Open the BIBLE.IS app and tap on the Reading Plan titled “ONE 2021.”
3. Follow the plan and listen for about 10 minutes a day for 47 days. Keep track of your progress in this workbook. In 47 days, you will have listened to all 4 gospels.
