HOW IT WORKS

LISTEN

- 1. Visit the APP STORE or GOOGLE PLAY and download the BIBLE.IS app.
- 2. Open the BIBLE.IS app and tap on the Reading Plan titled "ONE 2021."
- Follow the plan and listen for about 10 minutes a day for 47 days. Keep track of your progress in this workbook. In 47 days, you will have listened to all 4 gospels.
