10-47-4 is a churchwide campaign where participants will spend 10 minutes each day listening to passages in the gospels of Matthew, Luke, and John. Once a week, participants will watch a video depicting events as the text from the Book of Mark is read, then consider and answer a few questions. Participation in a weekly group meeting (either in-person or virtually) is encouraged. Each Sunday, Pastor will deliver a sermon related to the project. By Easter, participants will have saturated themselves in the Good News of Jesus!

It encompasses questions about whether or not you would like to participate, be it in-person or via Zoom, and about receiving a book. Paul and Sherry Sudolcan Dear supporters and ministry partners,

We want to take this time to thank you for your continued support and to let you know what God is doing in our lives. We have been praying for over three years for Belizean teachers and staff to come on board so that one day the school could be managed, and classes taught by Belizeans. We always knew God had a plan, but we were not sure what that plan would look like. We originally thought that it would take five years or longer for this to happen. But God, in his infinite wisdom, directed us away from Belize due to a worldwide virus outbreak and has begun answering the prayers we have prayed. Belize Bible College now has a school manager, two theology teachers, one English teacher, and an office manager, all of which are Belizeans. Praise the Lord!

So, what does this mean for us? We feel that we have laid a solid foundation for the college and that God is leading us to another area of ministry. We are seeking God for His direction. We plan to return to Belize in January or February, Lord willing, to finalize the transition. We want to encourage you to continue to give through the month of January. Our partners at CTEN will continue to collect our funds through January. If you support us by automatic draft, you will need to contact CTEN at (830) 896-8326 after you give your January support so that they will not draft again in February.

What will happen to the Belize Bible College? The college will continue to move forward with the new Belizean leadership. Ashley and I will continue to support and help the college where needed. What can you do to help us during this time? First and foremost, you can pray for us as we transition. It will be difficult saying goodbye to our friends and students that we have built relationships with. Secondly, you can continue to financially support us through this transition. We will have a lot of travel and shipping expenses. If God leads you to give more on top of your monthly support to help us in this way, that would be a huge blessing. We would also like to encourage you to support the Belize Bible College, if the Lord leads you to.
