We have been truly blessed to baptize 20 last year and will baptize nine on June 13th. Another great blessing is to watch a new 60'x60'x16' worship center being built. Though still in the developmental stages, our church body took the first opportunity to stand on the foundation and pray a blessing over the place.

Our vision for Belize began while living at Acres of Love Children's Home 22 years ago: Spiritual formation, visionary, buildings/



grounds, school (college), and children's home is what we heard that day back in 1999. What we didn't know at the time was the most important part in bringing that vision to fruition was the fact that the Spiritual Formation really meant CHURCH. Once the church was formed, everything else began to fall into place. It's true, God does work in mysterious ways, but HIS church is always in the middle of it. "For where two or three are gathered in My name, I am there in the midst of them." Matthew 18:20.

I mentioned earlier when we moved to Belize, we lived at a place called Acres of Love. The property has changed hands twice since those days, and I am thankful to say the latest purchase was to our ministry on January 20, 2021. One of our board members asked if he could share the need to pay for this property with his Church's missions committee. From that first contri-

bution, the land was paid off within ten days. We praise God and give HIM Glory! Please pray with us to know God's will for this property. 


