# PASTOR SEARCH UPDATE

Since the formation of the Pastor Search Committee (PSC) in late March, we have met several times to organize our work, assign roles and responsibilities, and study the Texas Baptist's Pastor Search manual as our guide. We also met with and received training from two Texas Baptist representatives. We are now ready to communicate with you three major milestones in the Pastor Search process that are on the near horizon for our congregation.

First, the PSC is currently working to complete the Church and Community profiles. Members of the team will be meeting with as many of the congregation as possible to discuss and document the church's history, current status, and vision for God's future direction of our congregation. We expect to have this step completed in *mid June*.

Next, the PSC will be working with members of the church to build the Pastor Profile. We will again be meeting with as many of the congregation as possible to discuss and document the qualifications of the pastor best suited to lead our congregation in the direction determined by the Community and Church profiles. We want to complete this step by *late June*.

Finally, by *late July* our third milestone will be to assess, together with the Finance and Personnel committees, whether we are able to proceed with the candidate assessment phase of our work.

We realize this is a busy time of the year with vacation and family plans, but please make an extra effort to attend Sunday School and Special Called Church Business Meetings so you can participate in the search and provide valuable input to the process.

Please remember to *pray* for the members of the team, for God's wisdom and leading for ourselves and the entire church family.


