THOUGHTS FROM MATT

I was grateful for the opportunity to take a group of parents and students to Corpus a couple weeks ago to an apologetics conference. We heard speakers like Lee Strobal and others talk about how to have a compelling faith that engages people who do not know Jesus. One of the highlights for me was a breakout session on the problem of evil. So, I wanted to take a little bit of your time to talk about how Christians can respond to this question. What is the problem of evil?

1. If God is good, all-powerful, and all-knowing, he wouldn't allow evil to exist

2. Evil exists

3. Therefore, God doesn't exist.

There are a couple of common ways for Christians to address this question. First, the free will defense is an argument that free creatures (humans) must have the possibility of committing evil acts. God created us to worship, but in order for us to freely worship the Lord we also have to have the capacity to freely not worship the Lord. Our ability to truly love others is also what gives us the ability to truly hate others. Therefore, evil exists in the world because God saw that it was better to create free beings rather than create robots. We know that the Lord is seeking those who freely worship Him in Spirit and truth. (John 4:23) This creates the possibility for some terrible things to happen in our world.

Second, the greater good defense is an argument that if God is all-knowing, allpowerful, and good, he has the ability to bring about a greater good from any situation that is evil. This is a difficult argument for many because often we cannot see what this good might be. We believe that God rules over all things and that nothing can thwart His plans. (Job 42:2) Nothing is impossible for God. (Matthew 19:26) Is anything too hard for the Lord? (Genesis 18:14) He can bring about a greater good from any situation, for our good and to His glory.

Third, the argument that is most compelling to me is the argument that you would tell the one who is suffering. If someone just lost their best friend or their spouse it probably is not wise to say, "You don't need to be sad that this terrible thing has happened, here are 14 reasons why the problem of evil argument can be logically overcome." No, the suffering person needs the comfort of God, not a lecture. The suffering spouse needs compassion, not a textbook. The suffering parent needs love, not cold-hearted logic.

This is the very thing we find in Jesus. We find one who has tasted suffering, temptation, despair, and death for us. (Hebrews 4:14-16) God is not an uncaring, distant, indifferent God. No, He is the triune God (Father, Son, and Spirit) who loves us so much that He sent His Son to take on flesh and ransom us. Here is our resource in the problem of evil. Here is our resource when you are sitting with a person who feels hopeless. God truly does care, God truly does love us and he has proven it once and for all in the sending of His Son. He is sufficient in our despair.

Our choir meets on Wednesday evenings at 7:30 pm.


