Thoughts from Matt

Learning from the Past

I've been reading Jonathan Edwards' book *Religious Affections. It was published in 1746 but was originally a series* of sermons written 4 years prior. The context of the sermons were the First Great Awakening in the 1730's and 1740's. These awakenings often involved large gatherings both inside and outside of churches that resulted in many people proclaiming faith in Jesus, confessing their sins openly, and oftentimes showing a lot of visible emotions. Some pastors thought that some of these meetings were overly emotional and out of control. Edwards' actually criticized George Whitfield (the most popular preacher of the Great Awakening) for both allowing and encouraging these meetings to get out of control.

Why does any of this matter? An interesting issue that Edwards' brings up is that as a part of these meetings, some people would respond by saying that the Lord directly gave a Bible passage to their minds to prove that they were a Christian. It was not the truths of the Bible verse that mattered, but the experience of simply the verse popping into their heads. In other words, some people were saying, "This Bible verse popped into my head in the middle of the worship service, therefore I'm a Christian." This might seem like a strange situation to you because we typically don't see this happening in the middle of our worship services. I've never seen a person stand up and interrupt a worship service shouting, "I know I'm a Christian because God made John 3:16 pop into my head right now." So, does this matter to us? Absolutely! We need to know what the foundation of our assurance is. Praise the Lord, if He helps you remember Bible passages! Praise the Lord, if He brings to mind a Bible verse that applies directly to a situation you are dealing with right now. That's such an amazing grace from God if that happens...but that experience is not the foundation for your assurance.

This is the foundation of your assurance,

"And to the one who does not work but believes in him who justifies the ungodly, <u>his faith</u> is counted as righteousness" (Romans 4:5);

"Therefore, since we have been justified <u>by faith</u>, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ". (Romans 5:1)

Our right standing with God is based on our faith in the finished work of Jesus, not in an emotional experience. Now, don't hear me say something I'm not saying. Praise God for the times in our life where we <u>feel</u> the Lord draw near. Praise God for the times when we are reading or are reminded of a passage of Scripture that stirs our hearts. Praise God when we are in a worship service and we hear the words of a song that meets us right where we are and our emotions are stirred. These are all great things that we need to thank God for but they are not the foundation of our assurance. This next part might be a tough read but bear with me here.

"If a sinner be once convinced of the veracity [truthfulness] of God, and that the Scriptures are His Word, he will need no more to convince and satisfy him that he is invited; for the Scriptures are full of invitations to sinners, to the chief of sinners, to come and partake of the benefits of the gospel;." (Edwards, Religious Affections, pg. 151)

Here is how I understand this. The invitation is there already. You don't need a new truth or a new experience to know that God created you for a relationship with Him. You don't need a new truth to know that you have rebelled against the Lord. You don't need a new experience to know that God loves you perfectly by sending His Son to live perfectly for your sake, to die on a cross to take your punishment, to rise again in resurrection to defeat death for you, and to ascend to the right hand of the Father to forever make intercession for you.

These are all truths displayed in God's Word. You do need to make your faith your own and sometimes that might involve emotions. You do need to understand the importance and exclusive nature of the gospel. You do need to get excited about these truths, but the grounding of your faith is not in who you are and what you've done, but in who Jesus is and what He has done!
