To First Baptist Floresville,

I'd like to leave the church with a challenge. We can become so distracted and spend so much of our time on the urgent but not important. We can spend our time on good gifts that God has given us but have possibly become distractions that take our focus off of the main thing. First Baptist Floresville is called to be a kingdom outpost, a gospel lighthouse for Floresville and beyond. In all of the possible committee/deacon/ministry meetings you will have over the coming months, here are some questions I challenge you to start asking:

- Who is leading the charge to equip the church to share the gospel?
- Who is spending time leading the church to pray for those who don't know Jesus?
- Who is spending time making disciples (on a personal level) of other Christians?
- Whose heart is breaking right now because there are people in this world who spend a lifetime never hearing the gospel?

None of these questions requires a pastor to answer them.

The great commission (Matthew 28:18-20) is not for pastors alone, but a challenge to all Christians. So find answers to these questions. First Baptist Church has the gifting for seeking the fulfillment of the great commission. (1 Corinthians 12) It does not matter if you are 17 or 70 you are called to take a part in seeking the fulfillment of the Great Commission. There is no room for "I've done my time" or "I'm too young." Why should you do this? I want to leave you with a quote from Jim Elliot that provides motivation.

PASTOR SEARCH COMMITTEE


