Several years ago, when I was attending Southwestern Seminary in Fort Worth, I had the privilege of studying theology with Dr. Bert B. Dominy whom I've mentioned several times in my sermons. Dr. D passed away in 2021, but his legacy lives on in my heart and, hopefully, in my preaching and teaching.

One especially meaningful aspect of the course was our study of the attributes of God. To understand the attributes means that we know *who* God is because of *what* He has done. While there are many attributes, including holiness, righteousness, power and ability, and knowledge, the one that has really remained with me over the years is God's attribute of love.

Love means learning to know God through his *loving actions* toward us. The most familiar word for "love" when connected with God is the well-known Greek word "*agape*." An "*agape*" kind of love says, "I love you, even though you aren't worthy of it." That's how God shows us *agape* love. He loves us even when we don't deserve it.

February is often thought of as the month of love, especially with Valentine's day. Red cards are already everywhere. Hearts, roses, candies, and, yes, Cupid. It's all headed our way faster than an F-15E Strike Eagle, maybe even a sermon series about love.

I encourage you to celebrate Valentine's Day and the love associated with it. But, for Christians, love is an everyday action, not just toward those you "really" love; but, to everyone. Even those who don't deserve it. Why? Well, because: God Himself is love (1 John 4:8, 16); God has demonstrated His love to us as sinners (Romans 5:8); and God's love is a giving kind of love (John 3:16). So, give that love, y'all!

#### TERRY'S NOTES

Howdy, again! Well, we are entering that time of year of San Antonio Stock Show and Rodeo, Presidents' Day, unpredictable South Texas winter, and last, but not least, VALENTINES DAY!!! That's right...VALENTINE'S DAY!

For some reason, VALENTINE'S DAY, during my elementary school days, was one of the highlights of the school year, not to mention the cool classroom parties we used to have, when there were such things. It was super neat to get cards from the other classmates, and sometimes we would receive special valentine treats or gifts from other best friends, which made VALENTINE'S DAY even more special. I remember my siblings and I would receive a Valentine card from my grandmother Smith. Inside the card, she would have a dime taped down, so that we could, if we chose, to walk down to the local drive-in store and buy candy or whatever. (A dime in 1965 was worth a lot more than today)

After doing a little google research on the origin of VALENTINE'S DAY, I discovered some pretty rather bizarre pagan facts about this special day. Not until the last few hundred years did VALENTINE'S DAY become more of what it is known for today: a day of expressing our love to one another by giving and exchanging cards and gifts. VALENTINE'S DAY is a special day for expressing our love for one another. So much money is spent during this time of year, thus, resulting in being a multi-billion dollar revenue holiday! Crazy huh?

Let's talk about love a little further. The greatest commandment in the Bible is found in Matthew 22:37: "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind....the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself."

As a Christian, it is my top priority to practice this Scripture verse daily. To me, to love God with all my heart, soul and mind, means to daily devote all of these aspects of my life to Him. My emotions, my will, my desires, my actions, my reactions, and even my physical health should all be surrendered to God. That means that I must have that special time with Him each day, no matter if it is early in the morning or later in the day. For me, early morning, no doubt, is best for me. When I meet with my Father God in the morning, I will immediately acknowledge Him as Sovereign God, and I begin to praise His Holy name. I, then, confess my shortcomings and sin to Him, according to 1 John 1:9. Then, I begin to thank my Heavenly Father for everything and in everything, according to 1 Thessalonians 5:18. The next thing I do is pray for my family, friends, the sick, my Church, etc.... Last, but not least, I pray for my needs. The next thing I do in expressing my love to God is to read His Word. I will usually begin with a devotion, followed by my daily Bible reading/ study.

For some reason, loving my neighbor does not seem as easy. As I live out my day, I encounter my neighbors at home, the neighborhood, at work, at the store, at the restaurant, in the school car lines; I encounter neighbors everywhere! I am commanded to love them the way I love myself. I am to put them first, instead of myself. For example, I am not to get angry when a crazy driver almost runs over me at the grocery store parking lot. I treat a family member with love and understanding when they fuss at me for having the TV volume up too loud! (oops) As a church goer, I kindly allow someone to sit in my seat at church, even if that is "my seat." (Clearing throat) These expressions of loving our neighbors goes on and on.

How about forgiveness being a form of loving our neighbor? Indeed! Is there someone in your life you have had a very difficult time forgiving? I have had several. First of all, Ephesians 4:32 says, "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as Christ God forgave you." Matthew 6:14-15 says, "Yes, if you forgive others for their sins, your Father in heaven will also forgive you for your sins. But if you don't forgive others, your Father in heaven will not forgive your sins."

After sharing these last paragraphs about VALENTINE'S DAY and loving God and our neighbors, I would like to suggest a VALENTINE'S DAY card for you to give someone. That someone who you have resented for quite a while, who may have offended you in the most extreme way. You know, that person who talked about you. That person who did you wrong. Yes! That person. Have you forgiven him or her? Maybe this year, you could write them a letter or card, give them a call, or even invite them to lunch or dinner, and have a time of reconciling. You know, God will bless you beyond measure if you will do this! What better VALENTINE'S DAY gift to give someone this year.
