Pastors Thoughts

The Essential "Controller"

At one time, it took effort and no small amount of pocket change to call people in Japan, or Wisconsin, or even Houston. Remember when you had to use an operator? OK, many of you don't, but I do. Frankly, I always enjoyed hearing the operator in some of those far away, exotic places like Massachusetts talk with that "funny accent."

But, with our technologically "flat world," people in Memphis can do business with people in Mumbai by email or phone or Skype with little cost.

In his book, *The World is Flat*, Thomas L. Friedman includes a story of a Japanese cell phone company going by the short title of *DoCoMo*. *DoCoMo* is an abbreviation for Do Communication Over the Mobile Network. It just happens also to be the Japanese word for "anywhere."

I'm also convinced that the words of one *DoCoMo* executive have come true; said he: "We believe that the mobile phone will become the *essential controller* of a person's life." Really? Has it gone that far already? Maybe; because, with our mobile phones, *anybody* can reach us *anywhere* at *anytime*. Think about that sentence again: "We believe that the mobile phone will become the *essential controller* of a person's life."

I beg to differ. Even for the most technologically savvy follower of Christ I know, the *essential controller* must be none other than Christ Jesus. The Apostle Paul wrote: "So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness" (Col 2:6-7).

If you have trusted Jesus as your Savior, this text tells you to "continue to live *in him.*" Put down that phone! And, take up Jesus as the essential controller of your life.






