
Terry's Notes



Pick an age you would like to work with, finish the boxes for a group of 6 yourself, or let me know... we may already have items you can have to get your box(es) started, or you can ask for help or suggestions on the Facebook page I have set up for the purpose of keeping you informed on what is needed. 
