Terry and Sandra Smith

June 1, 2023 marks an amazing milestone at FBC, Floresville!

Terry Smith was called as our Minister of Music on that date, and is the longest serving Music Minister in our history! He and Sandra have faithfully served as a team, and we are grateful and blessed! Terry's most obvious ministry is the music for our church, including our Sunday morning Adult Choir and Praise Band (which has included music for two services until Covid.) He has successfully "walked that tightrope" straddling the demand for both hymns and contemporary music with a "blended music" service. He is also responsible for Team Kidz Praise, the Youth Praise Band, and anything that involves music in FBC. This has included music for many weddings and funerals throughout the years, plus special musical presentations at Christmas, Easter, Thanksgiving Community services, etc.

Other responsibilities include our Audio/Visual Ministry, and like with the youth and children's choirs, he is blessed with wonderful helpers to make it all work. Without the Audio/Visual Ministry, we wouldn't have good quality sound and projection each week, something that we all rely on.

Another area of ministry in which Terry leads is our Senior Adult Ministry. For years he has visited home-bound and nursing home residents, often being accompanied by a deacon. He has been such a blessing to these folks as he visits, prays with them, and brings joy to people who are often overlooked. This ministry includes planning an outing each month for the "Fun Bunch," driving the bus and taking seniors to restaurants, etc, for a little day trip. This is an eagerly anticipated event of fun and fellowship for many of our seniors.

Terry also drives the bus each Wednesday to pick up children and youth at our campuses after school to enable them to attend church activities, a tremendous outreach to families in our community. This act of service has brought in numerous kids to our programs over the years.

Terry wears "many hats" and has always been available in any area of service. He has officiated at occasional weddings and funerals, has counseled individuals and staff for various reasons, and if not doing the music himself, often runs the sound board during weddings and funerals. He has assisted in church services for the nursing homes, V.A. home, and has driven the bus to take the youth to camp (and often stayed as a camp counselor) for many years.

All over Floresville Terry is known as a friendly and humble man with a true servant heart. Sandra has worked beside him (like in coordinating weddings, etc.) and behind the scenes, but together, they are a real team! Terry serves in both big and small ways, but no act of service is insignificant. For example, he gets to the church every Sunday morning at 6:30 to turn on the heat or air conditioning, lights, coffee pots, etc. so everything is ready and comfortable when we arrive. On many occasions he has driven senior adults to San Antonio doctor appointments when needed, and over the past six months has been our only full-time pastoral staff member available to us. Philippians 2:3 comes to mind when we think about Terry and Sandra's humble, gentle spirits. "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves." God has blessed us abundantly with Bro. Terry & Sandra, and we are SO grateful! Let's congratulate and celebrate them all month!!!

Terry Smith was born on May 31, 1958 in Pleasanton, the third of six children (one girl and five boys.) His love for music began at age 6 when his grandparents gave him a small toy organ. Later in high school, he practiced on the church piano after school. Terry's family moved to Bishop with his dad's job, and he graduated from Bishop High School in 1976. Out of his graduating class of 90, three friends followed the Lord in full time worship ministry and remain close friends to this day. Terry attended Texas A&I University, and later served a year with Friendship Ministries based in Colorado Springs, CO. This ministry traveled around the U.S. holding backyard Bible Clubs and performing concerts at schools, churches, schools, nursing homes, and prisons. It was during this time that Terry felt the Lord calling him into full-time ministry. Following this ministry, Terry served in several churches in Texas, including Jonestown, where he met Sandra, who was serving as an interim youth leader. The first time they met, she called him "Brother Smith," a point of humor to this day. (Now, when he's "in trouble," she calls him "Terry Dale!") They were married in 1985 and later added two daughters, Bethany and Rachel to the family.

Terry served as a Superintendent and Administrator of a small private school in Austin, in addition to being the church's music minister. In 1999, he was called to Trinity Baptist in Pleasanton, the church where he was baptized as a child. He served there until being called to FBC, Floresville on June 1, 2003.

Terry has also been an active member of the Singing Men of South Texas (SMOST) since 1999. This group is comprised of current and retired ministers of music dedicated to sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ in our nation and abroad. One of the highlights of this ministry was in 2012 when Terry and Sandra, serving with SMOST, took a two-week mission trip to Ukraine—an experience they will never forget and for which they will always appreciate the generosity of FBC members who helped sponsor their trip.

Terry and Sandra have two grown daughters (Bethany & Rachel), two sons-in-law, and one beautiful little granddaughter, Audrey, who lights up their world! They are also blessed with a church family who loves and appreciates them!


Operation Christmas Child is at work in the background and we now have 20 boxes packed. 14 of those boxes have a panda bear to make a little girl quite happy.
