A Word from Pastor Ben

Mismanaged, but leaving it in Jesus' hands

Honest now. Have you ever attended a potluck meal, this church or any other, without bringing a dish? "Oh, don't worry about it," people say. "There's enough food in there for an army." So, you and 20 others decide to attend without bringing any food.

Y'all go through the line and get your food, thankful for the generosity of others. Then, you can't help but notice that, somebody near the back of the line picks up a serving spoon and promptly drops it back into the bowl, obviously disappointed that whatever was in there, something they really wanted, is all gone. That's when you resolve that you won't take that run by the dessert table after all, but then you look over there and see a buttermilk pie and, well, there are some powers stronger than guilt.

Whether that's ever happened to you or not, the mere prospect of a Baptist food failure forces us to answer a question, "Whose responsibility is it?"

You ever wonder if Mary, the mother of Jesus, was asking the same question the day of the wedding feast in Cana when the wine went dry (John 2:3)? Who's responsible? Maybe the wedding planners should have figured on unexpected guests who'd drink more than they should. Maybe those generous voices who didn't help plan things, but who seized the authority to welcome those who arrived with empty hands, should share the blame. Or, maybe it's all those unexpected guests, who didn't bring stuff to eat, and who become the direct causes of the wine fiasco? Who's responsible when the meal is mismanaged?

Who knows? Jesus has just called a bunch of new disciples and brought them with him to the wedding. They sure didn't have time to prepare anything. Did they drink more than expected? Is that why Jesus' mother goes to Him for a "special" (= miraculous) solution?

The problem is, according to Jesus, "My hour has not yet come" (John 2:4b). He means that it couldn't be Mary, his own mother, who would dictate the terms as to when Jesus should step up and begin his Messianic ministry. God alone is the One who would choose the timing. We don't understand a lot about God's timing either. At least, I don't. I often wonder when God will act on my behalf. But, I can't force it; neither can you. Instead, we pray. We fervently pray our heart's desire, maybe even hoping (?) to change God's mind. But, bottom line: we have to leave it all in Jesus' hands.


VBS UPDATE




