The headline appeared with an article in Christianity Today which went on to contend that "a large share of Christians are opting to go it alone, moving their faith into quarters so private that even the church is not allowed in." From there, it suggests that our emptier pews are fast becoming a "public health crisis."

The argument is that, frankly, regular attendance in church worship services improves not just our spiritual well-being, but our overall health, too. Granted, there aren't data sets to prove that point and, certainly, the gospel was never intended to improve our cholesterol numbers or lower your blood pressure. However, hearing the good news (instead of all the bad news!) could just make a practical (medical?) difference in our lives, regardless of statistics in short supply.

The most important component of our overall health, I remain convinced, is to know and love God as you are known and loved by him. So, determine that you and your family will not be part of this American public health crisis. Let's fill the pews of FBC, Floresville this and every Sunday!

#### "In His Image" Youth Camp 2023

This year the Youth Group attended MFuge camp, at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Ft Worth Texas and the theme was "In His Image."

The Students learned that at some point in our lives, we have all struggled with our image - what we look like, who we really are, how we fit in, what we stand for. As humans, all of us are uniquely created in the image of God. If you believe this to be true, what does that mean for your life and others around you? As Christians, we are called to bear this image like Christ did on earth. Therefore, we are called to live as a new creation, one who is set apart and is a reflection of the God who created us and loves us.

MFuge is centered around missions. Half of our group hosted a VBS at a battered women's shelter, where women and their children can live there for up to year. It was amazing to see the difference in the kids' faces after a week of being there with them. The other half of our group cleaned a city park by picking up trash and writing bible verses on the sidewalks, helped out in a food pantry and a thrift store. Needless to say we were busy and we made an impact on the Ft. Worth community.

Some of the kids that attended camp this year grew up in church and others, just joined our youth group and are just learning about Christ. It was amazing to see how God worked in these 21 kids' lives during this week. God truly is bringing up the next generation for his kingdom of disciples and I am so excited to see what they will do for Christ!

Thank you so much to our adult volunteers, Mike Hopper, Scott Davis, Stacy Collins and Stephanie Jenkins for taking these kids to camp and a huge thank you to our church family for supporting the Youth Group and your generous donations that allowed all of these kids to go to camp.


