Thoughts from Pastor Michael

Philippians 3:13-14 (HCSB) "Brothers, I do not consider myself to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and reaching forward to what is ahead, I pursue as my goal the prize promised by God's heavenly call in Christ Jesus."

Dear Church Family! Robin and I thank you for all of your expressions of love and encouragement since we arrived in Floresville and through this Christmas season! We appreciate each of you very much! The Lord has shown His love tremendously to us through you!

The original Greek language used in the above verses compares Paul's pursuit of knowing Christ and becoming like Him in character, to a sprinter blazing down a track with all his effort, stretching and reaching for the tape at the end of the race. Paul had a passion for Christ!

Many who struggle in their pursuit to know God think Paul must of had something extra that enabled him to be zealous in his relationship with Jesus. Paul pursued the Lord vigorously because he knew the zeal that Christ had for him.(v.12) Christ had run down the infamous persecutor of the church on the road to Damascus and had made him the famous apostle of the church. Paul was overwhelmed with this love. He felt it and was compelled by it every day of His life. (2 Cor.5.14)

Do you think of Christ loving you just as He loved Paul? Do you think He cherishes you and will chase after you just as He did him? If we don't feel precious to the Lord, then He won't be highly valued by us. If we think that God is not very interested in us, then we won't be interested in Him. Christmas and Easter is part of the proof that we are precious and pursued.

In order for us to know Him, He journeyed from the praise of angels to the stench of a stable. He became a baby, and spent His first night in a feeding trough. He humbly kept pursuing each of us through His obedience for 33 years until His dying breath, having been nailed to a cross for our sins. All of this, including the resurrection, happened because He desperately wants you and me to be one with Him. After we meet Him, He still pursues us, wanting us to share our tears and our joys with Him, as He shares His life and secrets with us, His treasured friends. Each day He wants us to hear His voice, feel His Presence, and be consumed by His love. As this happens we will be so captivated by Him that we will pursue Him with all of our soul, for He will have become the delight of our soul. Isn't that the secret of it all?

The same God Who pursued Adam and Eve after the fall, Hagar in the wilderness, David in his murder and adultery, Jonah on the run from his mission, the disciples in a boat on a stormy night, and Peter in his denials...is chasing after us right now.

Oh, precious Christ! Your goodness and mercy chases us all the days of our lives and you will cause us to live in your house forever. (Ps. 23.6) We praise your wonderful Name! Help us to seek You with all of our hearts each day this coming year! Pastor Michael Funderburk
