





Thoughts from Pastor Michael

As we enter this month that celebrates Valentine's Day, I am grateful to be part of a church family that practices love! Robin and I are so grateful to be here! I thought I would write this article based on love as it was described in the following verses.

1 Thessalonians 4:9-10 (HCSB) "About brotherly love: You don't need me to write you because you yourselves are taught by God to love one another. In fact, you are doing this toward all the brothers in the entire region of Macedonia. But we encourage you, brothers, to do so even more,"

2 Thessalonians 1:3 (HCSB) "We must always thank God for you, brothers. This is right, since your faith is flourishing and the love each one of you has for one another is increasing."

The Apostles wanted the early church to live in the Lord's love. Even though the Thessalonians were loving each other, Paul wanted it to happen "even more." John also emphasized love in His letters. According to Jerome, who lived from 354-430 AD and gave us the Latin translation of the Bible, John constantly emphasized love when he was dying. Jerome said that John was very frail in his final days of life in the city of Ephesus. He was so frail that he had to be carried into the church. There was one phrase that was on his lips constantly: "My little children, love one another." When asked why he always said this, John replied, "It is the Lord's command, and if this alone be done, it is enough."

Loving one another is so crucial! Jesus said that the world would know that we were His disciples if we loved one another. (John 13:34-35) It is no wonder that both Paul and John wanted God's people to love one another and to do so "even more."

How do we love other people "even more?" Psalm 32.10 says, "....But the one who trusts in the Lord will have faithful love surrounding him." In John 15:9 Jesus says, "....Abide in my love." You cannot produce it, but you can absorb and reflect it! The early church must have done so. Tertullian, born around 150 AD in northern Africa and one of the early church fathers, quotes a statement from the enemies of the early Christians and how they were viewed: "How they love each other."

Oh Father, enlarge our capacity to receive and reflect Your love! Grateful to be your Pastor!
