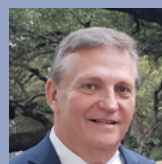

Thoughts from Pastor Michael

Genesis 1.2 "Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness covered the surface of the watery depths, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters."

Sometimes our circumstances may seem to be very dark, without form or without meaning as to what is happening. Yet this verse shows that in the formless period of the earth, the Holy Spirit was there hovering over all that was happening. The word "hovering" is also translated to flutter like a bird fluttering over its baby birds. It literally has the idea of cherishing. In this verse, the Hebrew suggests an action that is very intensive or intentional. The earth in the beginning may have appeared to be something that was in chaos. But the Lord was cherishing what He was doing and making everything happen just as He pleased.

He does the same thing through every hurt and dark moment of our lives. He may seem to be far removed from what is happening, but He is there cherishing you, hovering over you, and making His perfect plans unfold. We will look back one day and say with rejoicing "...He has done all things well.." (Mark 7.37) With joy, we might as well say it now.

I want to encourage you to not only find comfort in His sovereignty, but to also find comfort in His Presence. By faith, nestle under His fluttering wings, and rest your head on His heart that always beats with love for you!

Psalm 91.4 "He will cover you with His feathers; you will take refuge under His wings. His faithfulness will be a protective shield."

Deuteronomy 32.11 "As an eagle stirs up its nest, hovers over its young, spreading out its wings, taking them up, carrying them on its wings,..."

This event will be an opportunity for the parents \grandparents, along with the church, to pray for the child to make a decision to follow Christ when he/she is old enough and follow the Lord with a holy life.

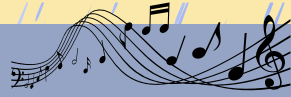

A word from the Deacons

Hello, FBC Church Family! I don't think you can know how blessed I feel to be a part of the fellowship at church. Judy and I talk about it all the time and the entire deacon body is thrilled to be in a position to be of service to the church as a whole and to each of you individually. Thank you all for the unity displayed in our family and for the love I feel and see among us all. Scripture reveals so many times and so many ways that we are to love one another just as God loves us. I see it happening here!

We, as your deacon body, have quite a few important roles to engage in as servants of the FBC family. One is that we are to involve ourselves in loyal support and respect for the pastor and staff. We are, in essence, to be an extension of the pastor and staff. They can only do so much in each day and only be in one place at a time. This is a blessing to them and to us as their servant helpers. Two, we are to at all times work faithfully to maintain unity in the church body. The enemy will go to any length to cause disharmony, strife, conflict, etc. in any way he can at any time.
