## Thoughts from Pastor Michael

1 Tim. 2.1 - "First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people." Verse 4 says that God "desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth." 2 Cor. 5.14 says "For the love of Christ controls us..."

As we pray for revival, let us also pray for specific lost people to be saved. If you don't have a specific lost person on your heart, ask the Lord to give you one or more to pray for daily.

As Eph. 4.15 says, we must "speak the truth in love." Adrian Rogers told a story that illustrates the importance of this verse and 2 Cor. 5.14 above.

"One day, a Christian decided to witness to an agnostic friend. She studied hard because she wanted to have all the answers. Armed with her knowledge and the Word of God, she presented the message of Jesus Christ with fear and trembling. The agnostic pushed back on everything with his wit, logic, sarcasm, hard heart, and ungodly mind. Every argument came back at her with another argument, and she was crushed. Moved to tears, she apologized. "I just wanted to share Jesus, and I wanted you to be saved." She left weeping.

Later, the agnostic admitted, "I'm sorry for the way I treated you. Please continue. Tell me about God. I need God. I'm sorry for my arrogance." She replied, "I can't understand it. What changed you?" The agnostic responded, "Your last argument. When you put your arm around me and wept and told me you loved me. I couldn't figure out what would make a person like you love someone like me unless what you had was real."




