A word from the Deacons

A Word from the Deacons

Hello to all of you, church family! Each one of you is so appreciated. Let's all thank God for each day and for His love and presence. One item in my daily prayer time is thankfulness for FBCF. Let us all ask Him for revival, outreach, growth and renewal. There are so very many outreach ministries we all have available. There are physical needs, widows, widowers, elderly needs, family needs, etc. We each have a purpose here. One thing that has been important to me lately is prayer for the search committee for our Family Pastor. Our families, and an intense focus on youth and young people is critical to the future of our church. Prov. 22:6 – "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it." Several points that are important in all our training have come to me a lot.

- 1 Gratitude. This determines the joy in life. If we are grateful, we will always be able to find joy. We need to guard it. Lack of gratitude causes many problems. Psalm 107:21 speaks of gratitude.
- 2 Integrity. Simply put, it is doing the right thing always, even when no one is keeping an eye on you. Prov. 11:3 focuses on integrity and its importance to us all. Remember, God sees it all!
- 3 Modesty. Being modest was the norm when I was growing up. I felt I had to struggle just to meet standards. Today, society is quite different. Just watch the evening news! Bible verse about modesty 1 Cor. 6:19-20.
- 4 Kindness. Kindness cures or solves everything! It should be on our To Do list every day! Try out Luke 6:35 for Our Kind Father's opinion on kindness in living each day.
- 5 Forgiveness. One powerful tool in so many ways. I have said for years that unforgiveness wears a person out. Forgiveness is for you first, then for the other person! Unforgiveness takes a toll because of the effects of hate, resentment, sorrow on the mind, body and emotions. Ephesians 4:32 gives the prescription for this disease.
- 6 Perseverance \Resilience \Endurance. These all go hand in hand. We are all to run the race, know God is on our side and to never give up hope. He has a plan for every detail. Perseverance Hebrews 12:1-2, Resilience Job 17:9, Endurance Matt. 10:22.
- 7 Faith. Easy explanation Believe even when we can't see it or prove it. Faith is so important to be taught to children and that they be taught God has a perfect plan at all times in all situations. He loves us all, and kids can build their own testimony by faith in God. See Isaiah 41:10.
- 8 Humility. This involves admitting mistakes, shortcomings and knowing we are imperfect. We sure are far from perfect! Any amens? Teach children humility by being the example. Check Prov. 11:2.
- 9 Being Close to God. This is essential to doing all these other items. Prayer, Bible study, listening to music and sermons on radio and TV, being at church faithfully, making good Christian friends with these values, meditation... all are blessings! Heb. 11:6 sums it all up.

The deacons strive to be faithful servants in prayer and service, willing and wanting to be of service to all of you. Feel free to call any of us at any time for anything! We mean it!

The new "committee year" starts in October. Some members will rotate off. Please start considering your strengths and where you can serve our church!

Rotating Committees

- Baptismal purpose: is to assist the Pastor and all candidates in preparation for baptism and to provide general oversight of the material and equipment necessary for the appropriate administering of the ordinance.
- Budget & Finance purpose: is to develop, present for approval, and administer the church budget. An additional purpose of the Budget and Finance Committee is to plan and promote special stewardship emphases and projects designed to broaden and strengthen the base of financial support for the church's ministries and programs.
- Church Council purpose: is to plan, coordinate, and evaluate the ministries, programs, and organizations of the Church. The Church Council is also responsible for educating the congregation in regard to policies and procedures adopted by the Church.
- Committee on Committees purpose: is to select, enlist and nominate persons to serve on church committees. The CoC helps reduce the large workload of the nominating committee.
- Fellowship/Hospitality purpose: is responsible for formulating and recommending to the church policies for the kitchen. These policies are to be communicated to the church members. The committee has the responsibility of planning and procuring volunteers to assist with church-wide socials.
- Family Ministry purpose: is to support the Pastor of Family Ministries in facilitating partnerships between the church and home. The Committee supports the Pastor in planning, organizing, and executing the events, activities, and direction related to preschool, children, student (birth – 12th grade), and family ministries at First Baptist Church Floresville (FBCF)
- **Master Planning purpose**: is the long-range planning committee is to develop the church's program of work for several years. The Master Plan committee studies the needs of the church and the community, comprises a plan and then reports to the Church for approval. A part of the process will be developing a mission statement that will set the course of the church in an ultimate sense.
- Nominating purpose: is to seek and enlist church members to fill the various organization positions for which the committee has responsibility and to submit those names to the church as nominees to be approved by the church.
- Personnel purpose: is to assist the church in matters related to employed personnel administration. The committee is responsible for staff needs, employment, salaries, benefits, and personnel services. Employees, other than ordained and licensed Pastors, shall be recommended to the church by the personnel committee and employed by church action. The Personnel Committee represents the church in working with the staff to give support and direction to the work of the church. The attitude of the Personnel Committee and the staff should be one of mutual respect.
- Lord's Supper purpose: is to assist the Pastor and Deacons by preparing the elements for the observance of the Lord's Supper. The Pastor and Deacons are responsible for leading the observance of the Lord's Supper and serving the elements to the Congregation.
- **Funeral Meal purpose**: is to provide an organized and shared procedure for the provision of meals to families of church members. When a death occurs, the Chairperson of the Funeral Committee shall be notified by the church office or Pastor immediately. The Chairperson will see that all meal arrangements are coordinated with the committee members, church staff and bereaved families.
