In 1623, the Pilgrims of Plymouth Plantation gave thanks to God for rain after a drought destroyed their crops

In 1578, the first known Thanksgiving service by Europeans in North America was held in Newfoundland.

In 1565, Historians believe the Spanish community in Saint Augustine, Florida celebrated the earliest Thanksgiving service in what is now the United States on September 8, 1565.

In 1598, Spanish explorers may have held a religious service at San Elizario in Texas.

Sarah Joseph Hale, editor of Godey's Lady Book, campaigned for an annual Thanksgiving holiday, which was established by President Abraham Lincoln in 1863.

In conclusion, what are you thankful for? I'm pretty certain most of you would say, "Christ and family." I would have to say, "Amen," to both answers! Of course, there are so many other things to be grateful for, as well. One of my favorite Scripture passages is 1 Thessalonians 5:18: "In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you." By claiming and living out this verse, my life has become more meaningful and positive. No matter if I am going through good or bad times, I always refer to this Scripture Passage.
