Thoughts from Pastor Michael

Philip Yancey writes: "Scientists now believe that if you had unlimited vision, you could hold a sewing needle at arm's length toward the night sky and see ten thousand galaxies in the eye of the needle. Move it an inch to the left and you'd find ten thousand more. Same to the right, or no matter where else you moved it. There are approximately a trillion galaxies out there, each encompassing an average of one hundred to two hundred billion stars."

THE GOD THAT MADE ALL OF THAT IS THE GOD WHO LOVES YOU AND ME!

How do I know? I know that, because I read in my Bible that **God died on a tree.....for me! We are His Valentine!**

In the gospels, I see the nail prints in His hands and feet. I see the crown of thorns on His brow. And I see the scar on His side made by a spear. All of that physical suffering was because of my sins. I also know there was a soul suffering which was worse than the physical suffering. There was not only the scourge that brought torture to His body, but there was also the scourge of His heart! He felt the guilt of our sins and fully drank the cup of wrath that I should have drunk! He was the propitiation (a sacrifice averting the wrath) for us all. (1 John 2.2)

When He died for the world, He wasn't just dying for a mass of faceless people. He was dying for each of us personally. (Gal. 2.20) As Augustine noted, "God loves each of us as if there were only one of us." He loves us all the same. He loves me like He did the apostle John or His mother Mary. In fact, John 17.23 says that He loves me even as (meaning to the same degree as) He loves Jesus!

What Zeal! May we be as zealous for Him!

As we abide in His love, we will be able to love Him, ourselves, and others with that same zealous love. And we will be able to be described as those in Revelation 12.11, "And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and **they did not love their lives to the death.**" **What zeal!**

As we begin February, may we examine our lives and be convinced that Jesus is our everything, the love of our lives! May we be convinced that we would die for Him if needed. In the 1500 hundreds, George Carpenter became a martyr for Christ. He was asked if he loved his wife and children who were weeping before him. His answer was this: "My wife and children!- my wife and children are dearer to me than all Bavaria; yet, for the love of Christ, I know them not."

May the Flame of Christ's love for us, enflame the fire of our love for Him!
Lord, make it so!

Everyone seemed so nice and friendly. I will have to say, though, our Golden Corral on Military Drive is a little bit better. One last thank you: Sandra and I want to say a big big thanks to all of you for the wonderful Christmas love offering gift! You are so kind to bless us with this blessing! We love all of you so much! We are so blessed to be part of the First Baptist Church Floresville Family!
