Thoughts from Pastor Michael

Mark 16.13 says, "Then they brought little children to Him, that He might touch them;..." Verse 16 says, "And He took them up in His arms, laid His hands on them, and blessed them."

Dear Church Family,

I love how Jesus not only touched the little children to bless them, but also "took them up in His arms" as well. Jesus reveals great love, warmth, and acceptance to the children. He so wants to bless them! He so wants to bless us!







