Give careful thought to do what is honorable in everyone's eyes. 18 If possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. 19 Friends, do not avenge yourselves; instead, leave room for God's wrath, because it is written, Vengeance belongs to me; I will repay, says the Lord. 20 But If your enemy is hungry, feed him. 

When You Come to a Fork in the Road



Hall of Fame catcher Yogi Berra was as famous for his "Yogi-isms" as he was for his baseball career.

One of his most quoted lines was: "When you come to a fork in the road, take it." Though humorous, it reminds us that life is filled with decisions—moments that shape the direction of our future.

Psalm 1 speaks directly to those crossroads. It tells us that the blessed person—the one who knows the deep joy, peace, and fulfillment of God—is marked not only by what they pursue, but also by what they avoid. They do not walk in the counsel of the wicked, linger on the path of sinners, or grow comfortable in the company of mockers. Instead, they delight in the Word of God and meditate on it day and night.

This delight is not casual or occasional; it is rooted, steady, and life-giving. The psalmist compares it to a tree planted by streams of water—nourished, fruitful, and enduring through every season. Such a life prospers, not necessarily in material wealth, but in the deeper prosperity of the soul: stability, fruitfulness, and God's favor.

The psalm also gives us the sobering contrast. Those who disregard God are like chaff—dry husks that the wind blows away. Without roots, they cannot endure the storm. Without substance, they cannot stand in God's judgment. In the end, two roads remain: one watched over by the Lord and leading to life, the other ending in destruction.

Early Christian writers saw in Psalm 1 a portrait of Christ Himself—the only One who perfectly lived this righteous life. Jesus is the Blessed Man, the One who resisted sin, delighted in the Father's Word, and now calls us to follow Him. When we choose His road, we find not only blessings in this life but also eternal life with Him.

So, when you come to a fork in the road, remember: only two paths lie before us. One leads to emptiness, the other to everlasting joy. Choose wisely. Choose Christ.




